

## Camp Visitors:

Visitors are welcome at either camp each Sunday afternoon. Visitors during camp sessions tends to disrupt the effectiveness of a camp, therefore it is discouraged. If you **MUST** contact a camper, **PLEASE** ask to speak with the director first !



## Health Information:

The Director **MUST** be made aware of any medical conditions a camper may have by indicating on the registration form! The Director will accept all medicines brought by campers upon their arrival on Sunday and dispense them from the "First Aid Station" during the week. An area hospital serves the camps in case of an emergency. The camps carry **INSURANCE** on all campers and staff members to cover accidents and sickness incurred at the camp. The cost is included in the camp fees !!

## Directions to Camp Carmel

**From TN.** go to Elizabethton and take Rt. 19E south to Rt. 194. Take Rt. 194 to Newland and make a left turn onto Rt. 181 in Newland. Take Rt. 181 to Rt. 221 and turn right on Rt. 221/181. Watch for sign on right to Camp Carmel.

**From Boone, NC** take Rt. 105 to Linville and turn right onto Rt. 221 to Rt. 181. Turn left onto Rt. 181/221 and watch for sign on right to Camp Carmel.

## Directions to Camp Placid

**From Bristol** go south on I-81 to Rt. 394 and go toward Blountville. In Blountville turn right onto Rt. 126 and go to Rt. 75. Turn left onto Rt. 75 and go to Camp Placid Rd. on left. Turn on Camp Placid Rd. to camp on right just beyond the pond.

**From Tri-Cities Airport** take Rt. 75 north to Camp Placid on right. Turn on Camp Placid Rd. to camp on the right, beyond the pond.

### **WHAT TO BRING**

**Appropriate clothing should reflect Christian values of modesty for everyone at camp !**

#### **BRING:**

**Clothing for warm days/cool nights**

**Clothing for hiking and recreation.**

**Sturdy jacket, hiking boots, 2 pairs of walking shoes, toilet articles, towels, rain gear, sleeping bag, BIBLE, pencils, paper, flashlight**

#### **DO NOT BRING:**

**Halter tops, spaghetti strap tops, 2 piece swim suits, short shorts and pants that hang below the waist.**

**Do Not Bring radios, CD players, all Electronic games, pagers and Cell phones.**

**Do Not bring snacks, food or drinks.**

#### **RULES:**

1. All campers are expected to remain at the camp unless there is an emergency.
2. Camp Directors will collect all car keys while youth are at camp. **NO cars will be driven from the camp while youth are attending camp.**
3. Use or possession of alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco, or firearms are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
4. Campers will be responsible for destruction of camp property and equipment.
5. Fishing is allowed by permit only at Camp Carmel and only with the director's permission.
6. No long distance phone calls from the camp except in emergency cases.
7. Respect and cooperate with directors and cabin leaders. Failure to cooperate with camp leaders will be cause for discipline by the directors. This may result in dismissal.
